GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OUTLINE:

- Applications for the scholarships are open to all Plainfield High School graduating seniors.
- Three (3) \$1,000.00 scholarships will be awarded.
- Scholarship applicants must have applied to and been accepted by a college, university or vocational training program and enrolled as a full time student before scholarship funds are awarded.
- Scholarship applications may be downloaded from the Plainfield Optimist Club website at: OPTIMISTINDIANA.ORG/CLUBS/PLAINFIELD (Click on College Scholarship under the Youth Work Page.)
- A scholarship selection committee will determine the recipient based upon the following:
 1. Proven ability to succeed in the classroom (GPA & Test Scores).
(Include a copy of you High School transcript and your SAT/ACT test results.)
 2. Involvement and achievement in extra curricular activities.
 3. Contribution to community through personal involvement and participation.
 4. Two (2) Letters of Recommendation.
 5. A 300 to 350 word essay.
- If the scholarship recipient fails to enroll as a full time student in the fall semester, the scholarship will be forfeited and will be awarded to another qualified applicant.
- The completed application must be returned to:

 - Plainfield, IN 46168Post marked no later than March 30, of your senior year.

Note: If two candidates are otherwise equally, or nearly equally, qualified, preference will be given to the applicant with the greatest need based upon family size and other scholarship offers.
