We have experienced some outstanding meeting programs, but I doubt any of them could top last Friday's show. Simon Crookall, the President and CEO of the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, gave a brief history of one of our city's treasures.

As one of sixteen full time orchestras in the US and one of only two non-government funded orchestras, the Symphony serves our community with 200 concerts per year.

The orchestra's mission is to use music to connect with people with emphasis on children. Simon stated that diversification sustains the model and he enumerated the number of ways it is done. Funding comes from public and private donations for a budget of \$28M. The 87 full time musicians play a wide variety of music from serious classical to the ever popular Pops concerts. On Saturday, we experienced the classical at Symphony on the Prairie with Mario Venzago conducting and a 13 year old girl from Westfield playing the piano. Despite the rain, it was a terrific performance.

Our program concluded with pianist and vocalist, Kelly treating us to an optimistic song we all know, "Smile". You could not help but smile after this DOC meeting.
